Charter Day School Open Enrollment Period To End June 10

The open enrollment period for Charter Day School in Brunswick County, which began Feb. 5, will be closing at 5 PM on June 10.

“We must receive your application by 5 PM June 10 for your child to be eligible for admission during the open enrollment period,” said Mr. Mark Cramer, Headmaster.

If the number of applications received exceeds the available number of openings in your child’s grade, then all applications for that grade will be placed in a lottery and assigned placement numbers as all are drawn. The lottery, if necessary, will be held on June 11 and is open to the public.

If your application is on file by June 10 and no lottery is required, then you are assured of your child’s eligibility for admission.

If, by the close of the open enrollment period June 10, there are still openings available in a grade, then students will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment applications received after June 10 will noted with the time and date received, and students become eligible for admission in the order received until all currently available openings are filled. Applications will be accepted after classes begin. Once a class is full, applications will be placed on a waiting list in the order received to be admitted to openings created by transfers as they become available.

“We are all very excited by the progress on campus and are on target to meet our goal of opening on July 18 for the first day of classes. We hope that parents will decide to let their children share in the learning environment that we are creating,” said Mr. Cramer.

Mr. Cramer said that although a large number of students have already enrolled, many parents still do not realize that charter schools are tuition-free. “They should investigate the possibilities and take advantage of this free choice that the state is offering them. We still have a number of vacancies available for any parent who wishes to enroll their child,” Mr. Cramer said. “In addition to our comprehensive curriculum and state-of-the-art facilities, we are trying hard to heighten awareness of the fact that we are free-of-charge, tax funded, and open to all students,” he added.
