Faison Joins Charter Day School Board

James H. Faison, III, has joined the Board of Trustees of Charter Day School, according to an announcement by Board Chair Beth Quinn. “Mr. Faison was the keynote speaker at our American Heritage celebration last spring. His willingness to give his time to speak and his ability to enthrall the students with his presentation made it obvious that we should approach him to help the school by becoming a Trustee,” said Ms. Quinn.

According to Ms. Quinn, the all-volunteer, ten-member Board concentrates on the broad policies and long-range plans that further the school’s mission and educational focus. “Our sole purpose as a charter school is to support the community’s continuing responsibility for educating our children and to provide an additional choice that is tuition-free for area parents. Mr. Faison brings a unique perspective of the area’s needs to the Board and will help us stay responsive to the needs of all citizens,” Ms. Quinn added.

Charter Day School has an enrollment of 516 students in grades K through 6 from five area counties – Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, New Hanover, and Pender – and is designated a “School of Distinction” by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction.
