As Headmaster, Mr. Cramer managed and grew one of North Carolina's largest charter schools. This rural school, 10 miles west of Leland, NC, has grown from an initial enrollment of 53 students in grades K-2 at its opening in 2000 to 750 students in grades K-8 in 2008-09. The school earned recognition as an *Honor School of Excellence* and has achieved the state's highest award as a *Top-25 School* in the state out of more than 1,850 K-8 schools. Despite receiving 35% less funding than surrounding schools, CDS has a substantial fund surplus.
